**ALERT**

**Home Heating Boiler Recalls  
due to  
Carbon Monoxide Hazard**

**U.S. Boiler Company Inc.** and **New Yorker Boiler Company Inc.** issued recalls of a number of home heating boilers as a result of possible carbon monoxide hazard. We have not heard of any incidents with respect to these boilers. We also understand that the hazard is unrelated to pressure containment components and some, if not all, of these boilers are small and thus not under the pressure equipment safety program provisions. We are not certain if any of the home heating boilers from New Yorker Boiler Company Inc. are installed in Canada but we understand that some of the boilers from U.S. Boiler Company Inc. could well be in use in Canada. In any case, you are urged to review the issue and contact the installer or distributor if you do have a boiler affected by the recalls.
