**CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION
NOT REQUIRED FOR
PRESSURIZED CARGO TRANSPORT VESSELS
UNDER THE ALBERTA SAFETY CODES ACT**

1.0 Background

Pressurized cargo transport vessels are now exempted from the requirements of the Safety Codes Act. Please see Information Bulletin No. IB01-002 for further details on the exemption.

2.0 Certificate of Inspection

For all pressurized cargo transport vessels, "Certificates of Inspection" will no longer be required under the Safety Codes Act. Accordingly, effective immediately, ABSA will not be issuing Certificates of Inspection for pressurized cargo transport vessels.

3.0 Implications

Previously, a valid "Certificate of Inspection" issued under the Safety Codes Act was required for a pressurized cargo transport vessel to be used in Alberta. It was also a requirement for shippers to check the validity of this certificate before a pressurized cargo transport vessel could be loaded or unloaded. Now there is no requirement under the Safety Codes Act for Certificates of Inspection for these pressurized cargo transport vessels.
