

Information Bulletin No. IB21-016 VARIANCE (VA21-008)

<i>Subject</i>	Variance to provide options for addressing Building Operator A, Building Operator B and Fireman's Certificates of Competency after they have expired.
<i>Date of Issue</i>	This Variance supersedes VA15-006 issued on April 23, 2015. November 10, 2021
<i>This Variance applies to</i>	<i>Province-wide Variance</i>
<i>Reason for variance</i>	The Power Engineers Regulation does not provide for renewal of a Building Operator A (BOA), Building Operator B (BOB) or Fireman's (Fireman) Certificate of Competency once it has expired but it does provide for renewal of other types of expired certificates. This Variance allows the renewal and upgrading of expired Building Operator and Fireman certificates.
<i>Details of variance</i>	<p>VARIANCE to Sections 11(2), 19.2(2), 20.2(1) and 20.2(2) of the Power Engineers Regulation (AR 85/2003).</p> <p>(a) Section 11(2) is hereby varied to allow the holder of an expired BOA, BOB or Fireman Certificate of Competency to apply for renewal of the certificate in accordance with Section 15 subject to the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(1) the certificate has been expired for a period not exceeding 3 years, or(2) the certificate has been expired for a period exceeding 3 years but less than 5 years and the applicant has related experience acceptable to the Administrator. <p>(b) Sections 19.2(2), 20.2(1) and 20.2(2) are hereby varied to allow the holder of an expired BOA, Fireman or BOB Certificate of Competency to apply to write a special examination to upgrade their expired Certificate of Competency, in accordance with the applicable sections, subject to the following condition:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(1) the applicant must successfully complete a course satisfactory to the Administrator. <p>Under Section 19.2(2), the applicant can upgrade from a BOA certificate to a 4th Class Certificate of Competency. Under Section 20.2(1), the applicant can upgrade from a Fireman certificate to a 5th Class Certificate of Competency.</p>

Under Section 20.2(2), the applicant can upgrade from a BOB certificate to a 5th Class Certificate of Competency.

Variance is specific and non-precedent setting

This Variance is specific and sets no precedent.

Contravention of a condition of this Variance is an offence under the Safety Codes Act.
