- Owners who do not hold an Owner-User Certificate of Authorization Permit must obtain ABSA acceptance for any proposed deferral that exceeds 10 percent of the inspection/servicing interval or six months, whichever is less.

*Note: This form shall only be used by Owner-Users that have provided an Integrity Management System in accordance with the Pressure Equipment Safety Regulation and has been issued a quality management system Certificate of Authorization Permit under PESR Section 11(3). Owners who do not hold an Owner-User Certificate of Authorization Permit shall consult with their local ABSA Safety Codes Officers for direction.*

Owners may encounter circumstances which require deferrals of small or large inventories of pressure equipment. Owners shall use this application to document efforts demonstrating equivalent safety. This application shall detail the safety monitoring plan implemented to mitigate unforeseen circumstances. Deferrals may be applied by the Owner and accepted by the ABSA Safety Codes Officer if all of the following conditions are met:

1. In addition to this form, a non-conformance in accordance with the owner's quality management system has been generated.
  - a. The corrective action shall describe the process used to defer the inspections.
  - b. The non-conformance report shall be presented to an ABSA Safety Codes Officer, who shall review the report and accept the disposition if they are satisfied the deferral process is reasonable in consideration of the circumstances.
2. **A Monitoring or Safety Plan has been implemented and documented.**
3. An indepth risk analysis has been completed and submitted which demonstrates equivalent safety with respect to the risk associated with the equipment during the deferral time period.
4. Deferral applications shall address the all of the minimum requirements listed in API 510 6.7.2.
5. Deferral times shall not exceed inspection intervals by half the full interval or 24 months, whichever is less. After which time the items shall be inspected and reassessed.
6. The Owner's Senior or Executive Management representative are in full agreement and support this application (this function can not be delegated).
